In our daily Literacy lessons, we will be writing and sharing

- stories in familiar settings
- letters, lists and posters
- songs and repetitive poems
- information texts

#### Year 1

- 1. Write, leaving spaces between words
- 2. Begin to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, a question or exclamation mark.

#### Year 2

1. Learn how to use punctuation correctly, incl. capital letters, full stops, question or exclamation marks
Learn how to use sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command.

PE



We have daily outdoor sessions. These are based around a range of games and exercise skills.

Music



We are using Oak National lessons to support our Music teaching. This term we are learning about pulse and rhythm.

### **Phonics**

We follow Letters and Sounds and have a phonics and handwriting session every day.

History & Geography

In History we will learn about things from the past and how they have changed and learn about some famous people.

## Numeracy



In our daily Numeracy lesson we will be learning about:

### Year 1:

- Sorting, counting and representing numbers to 10
- Addition facts to 10
- Subtraction facts to 10
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Comparing numbers to 20

#### Year 2:

- Number and place value to 20 and 50
- Addition and subtraction to 100
- Number bonds to 100
- Simple multiplication x2, x5, x10
- · Money and problem-solving

We will also have a weekly number bonds check and arithmetic lesson.
