What would your flag look like?




# MY WORLD...


Cut circles of different sizes and explore where you are in the world.

Use a split pin or some string to connect your world together.






 <b>NO SWIMMING</b> (high hazard)	 <b>SWIMMING AREA</b> (with lifeguards)	 <b>SURFING AREA</b> (no swimming)
 <b>CAUTION</b> (medium hazard)	 <b>DANGEROUS MARINE LIFE</b>	 <b>NO WATERCRAFTS &amp; SURFBOARDS</b>
 <b>SAFE TO SWIM</b> (calm conditions)	 <b>VERY DANGEROUS</b> (water closed to public use)	 <b>DIVING</b> (in progress)
