PARENT MEETINGS:

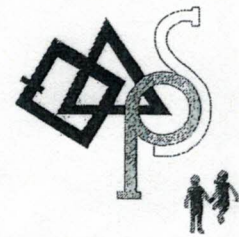
Given the current situation in relation to COVID 19 it will not be possible to hold our usual face to face meetings with you. We will send your child home with a settling in school report at the end of this half term.
