## Science



In Science we will be learning about;

- **Skeletons and Digestion** - looking at the systems of the body, the purpose and function of the skeleton and our digestive system.

## Art & DT



Our Art and DT topics this term we will be;

**Observational Drawing** - using different graded pencils, exploring different sketching techniques, practising pencil skills and shading.

**Chocolate Design and Packaging** - considering how chocolate is made, processes and how this is then manufactured and presented.

## Mathematics
