What do we look for when we redraft our work?

- **Sense** (words missed out, missing subjects, unclear meaning).
- **Spelling.** (Are you sure 'that word' is correct?
CHECK IT!)
- **Punctuation.** (Comma splices, missing full stops, inaccurate parenthesis)
- **Paragraphing.** (TiP ToP)
- **Have we hit ALL of our success criteria?**

I can address multiple and factor misconceptions

A multiple is the product of a number multiplied by a whole number.

For example, 10, 15 and 20 are all multiples of 5, as they are 5×2 , 5×3 and 5×4 respectively.

I can address multiple and factor misconceptions

A factor of a number is one that divides or multiplies exactly into a whole number.

For example, as $8 = 2 \times 4$, the numbers 2 and 4 would both be factors of 8 as they multiply evenly to equal it.

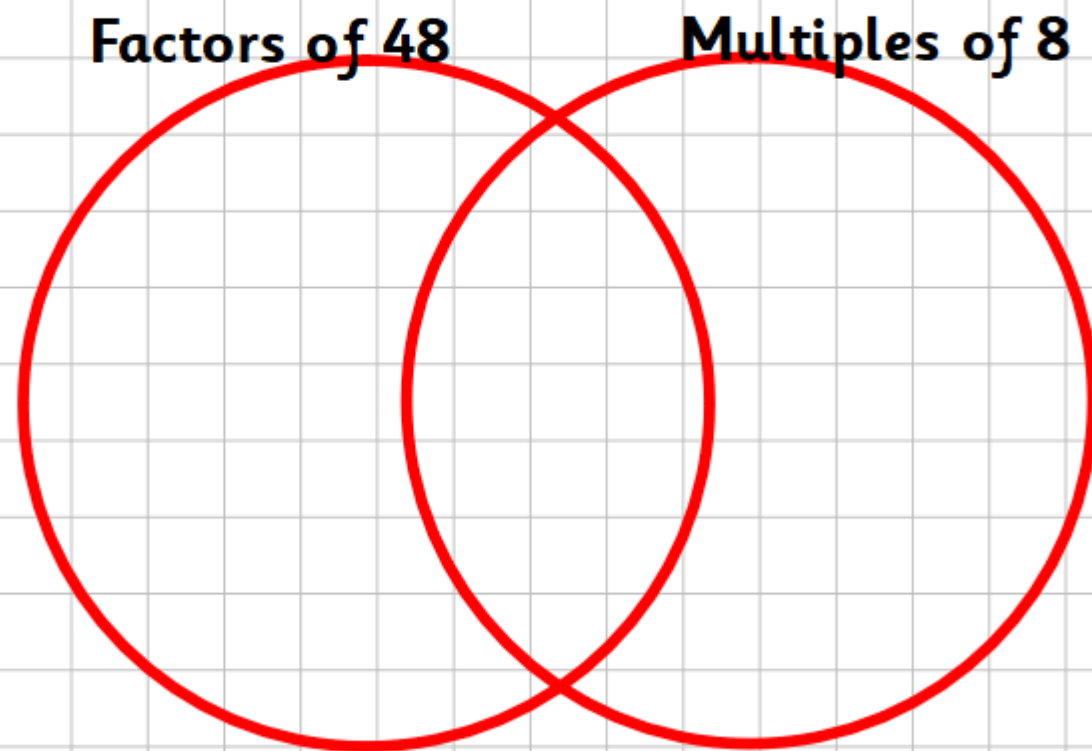

He gives her between £15 and £40.

The amount Annie receives is a multiple of 3 and 6.

The amount Annie receives is one more than a multiple of 5.

How much money does Annie receive?

$$0.5 \times 22 = 11$$

This means that 0.5 is a
factor of 11

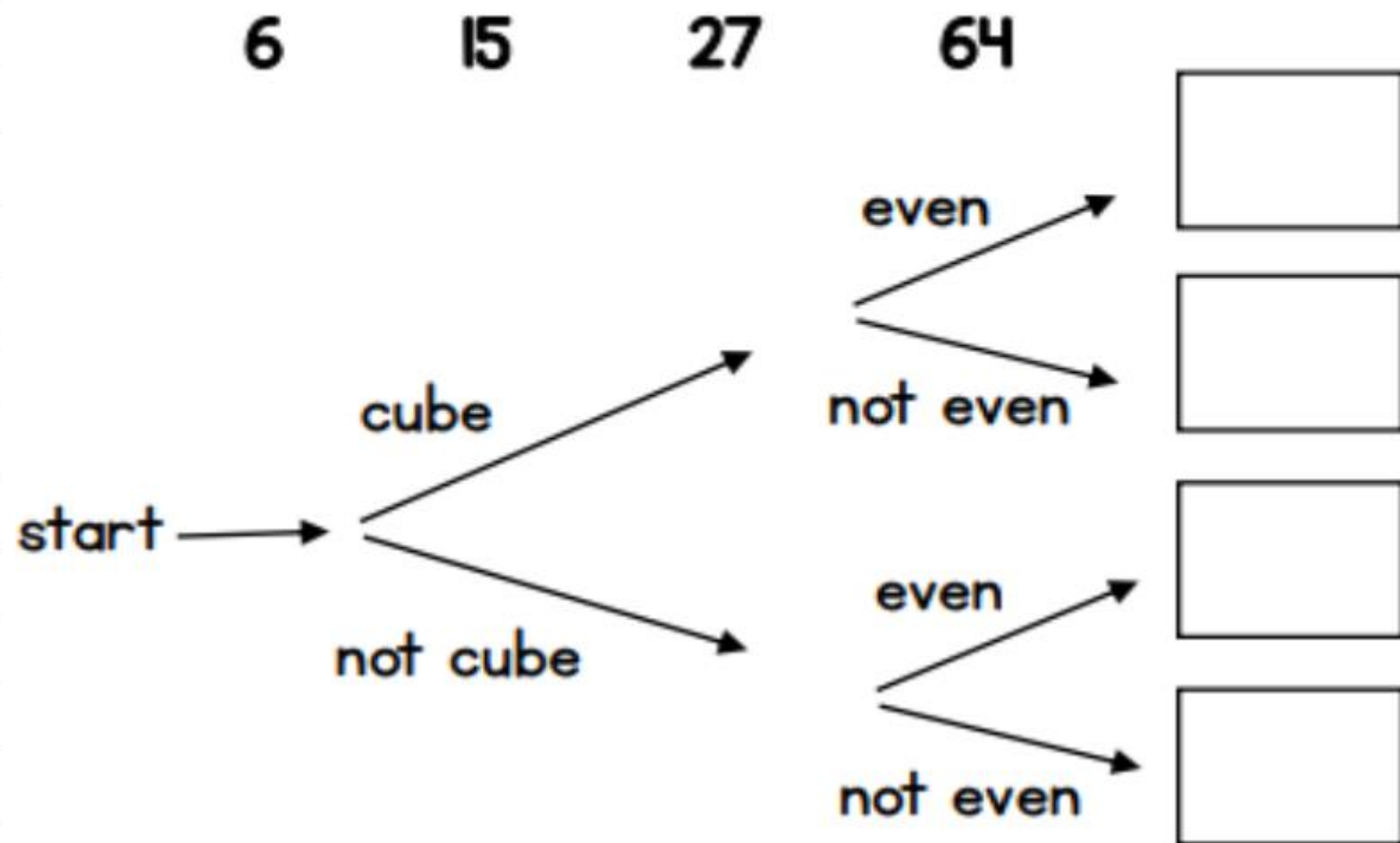
