What is a prime number?

Prime numbers are numbers that have only 2 factors: 1 and themselves.

What is a composite number?

A composite number is a positive integer which is not prime.

What is a squared number?

A square number is the product of a number multiplied by itself: $4^2 = 16$ (4×4).

What is a cubed number?

A cube number is a number multiplied by itself 3 times: $2^3 = 8$ ($2 \times 2 \times 2$)
