Happy New Year! We hope you had an enjoyable time over the holiday period. We look forward to working with you again this term.

COVID 19

We need to continue to support each other and try and keep everyone as safe and well as we can. In school we are balancing ventilation and warmth in class bases using CO2 monitors. We increase ventilation when needed. Please ensure your child has a warm coat, gloves, scarf and hat as we will be outdoors regularly.

Please continue to use the Lateral Flow Device (LFD) to check for COVID. If anyone has a positive LFD, **your child must stay at home and isolate for 7 days.** You can test on days 6 and 7 and if these results are both negative, your child can come back to school. They need a **negative result before they can return back to school.** Schools are required to report all COVID cases on a daily basis to the DFE, therefore we ask that you provide us with an email confirming the positive lateral flow from the NHS with the date. We upload daily work for your child on our school website www.manor.walsall.sch.uk under Children, Remote learning.
