We can use a timeline to help us organise important events in order by date and time.



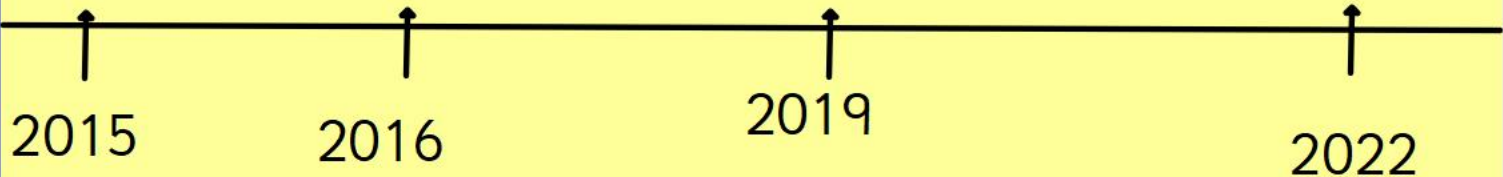
