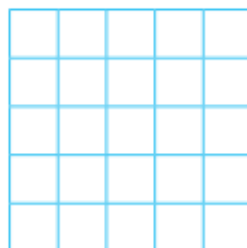

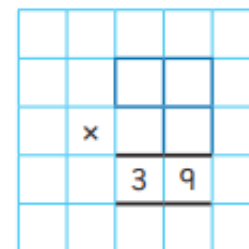

David Attenborough

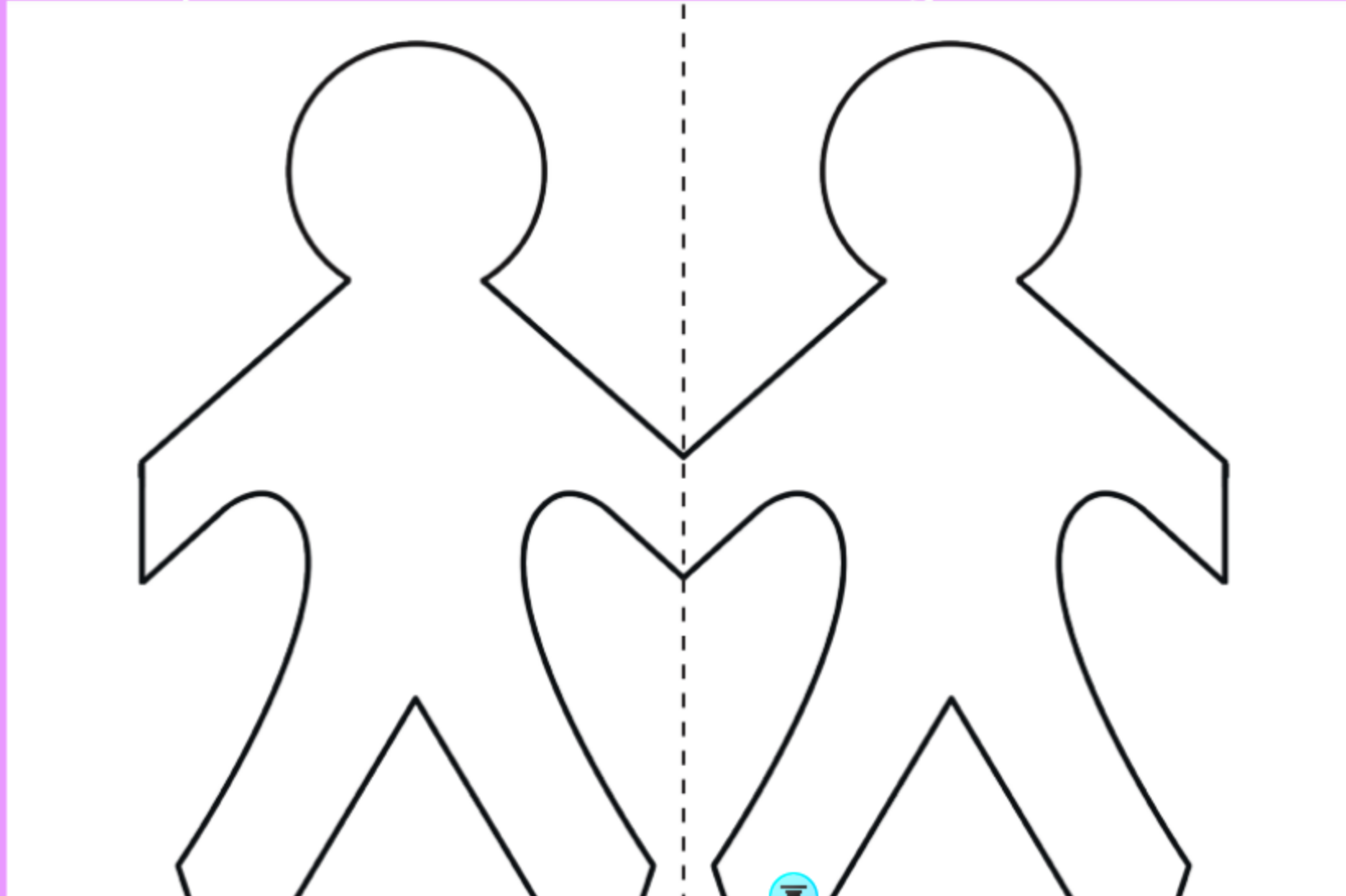
- Started out focusing on showing the natural wonders of the world.
