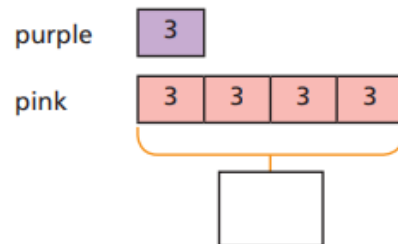

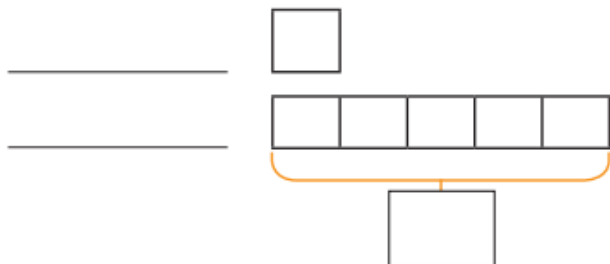




Christianity

There are many different denominations of Christians, but they all believe in Jesus Christ.





Christian Beliefs

God and Jesus

Christians believe in one God, they also call him the Father. They believe that he sent his son, Jesus Christ, to show people a good way to live their lives.

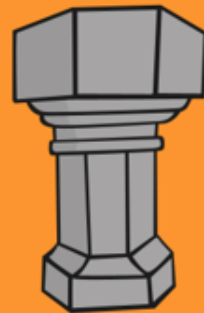
Jesus' most important messages from God were to love God and look after one another.



Christian Beliefs

Christians believe that God created the world.

God said "Let there be light!" and there was light. God separated light and dark and called the light "day" and the darkness "night". On the second day God made the earth and sky. On day three, God created the land and seas, along with plant and trees. On the fourth day, God created the sun, moon and stars then on the fifth day, the birds and sea creatures. On the sixth day, God made animals and Adam and Eve. On the final day, God rested.



The Bible

The Bible is the Christians holy book. It is divided into two sections the old testament and the new testament.



The Bible is full of stories of different peoples lives and stories Jesus told as examples of how Christians should live their lives.

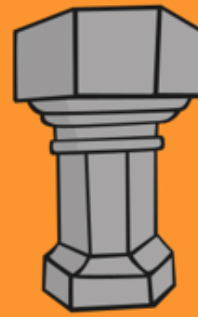


Holy Places

Symbols

Many Christians celebrate Easter by visiting church and giving, receiving and eating Easter eggs, which signify new life.

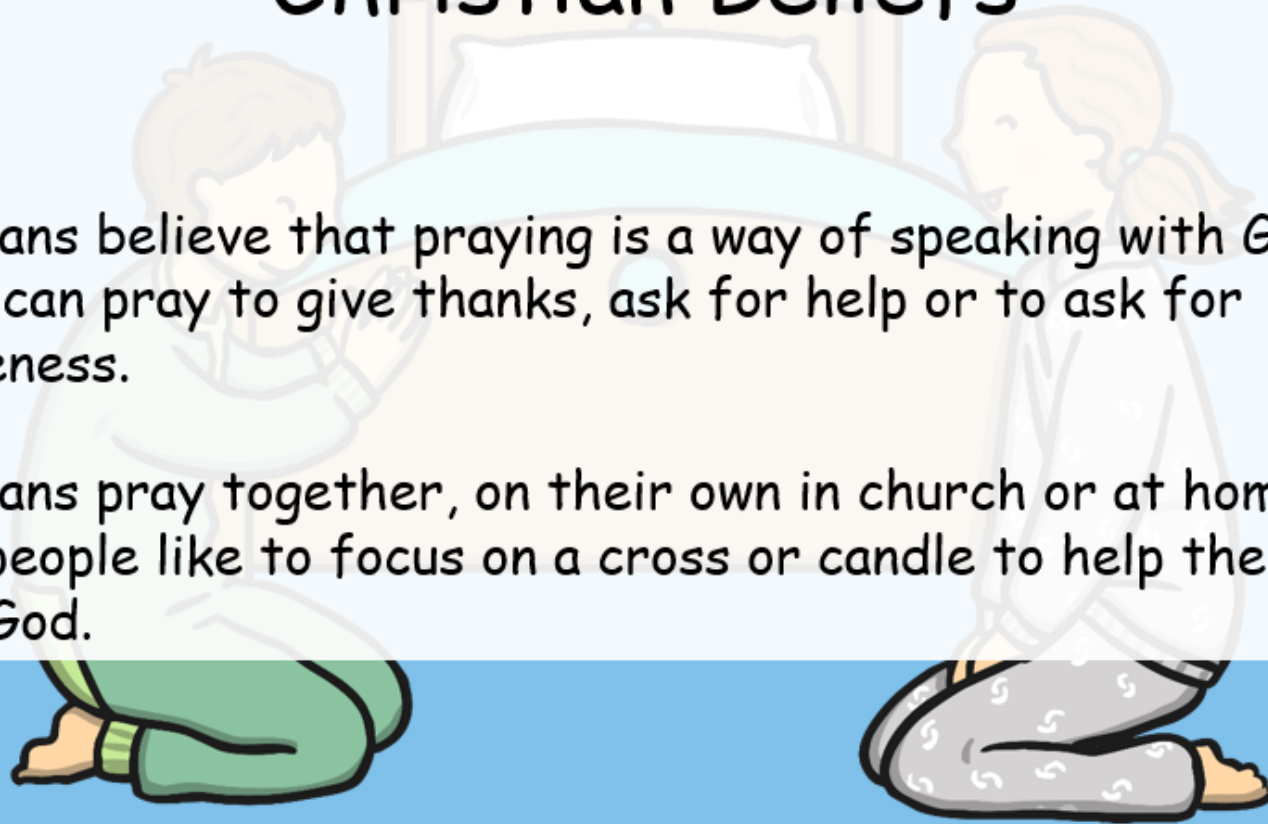


Christian Beliefs

Prayer


Christians believe that praying is a way of speaking with God. People can pray to give thanks, ask for help or to ask for forgiveness.

Christians pray together, on their own in church or at home. Some people like to focus on a cross or candle to help them think about God.

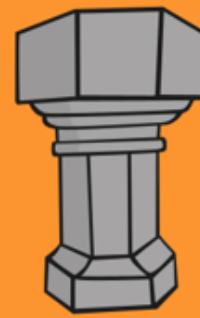


The Lord's Prayer
