I can revise my sketches and create my final Mayan textile panel.

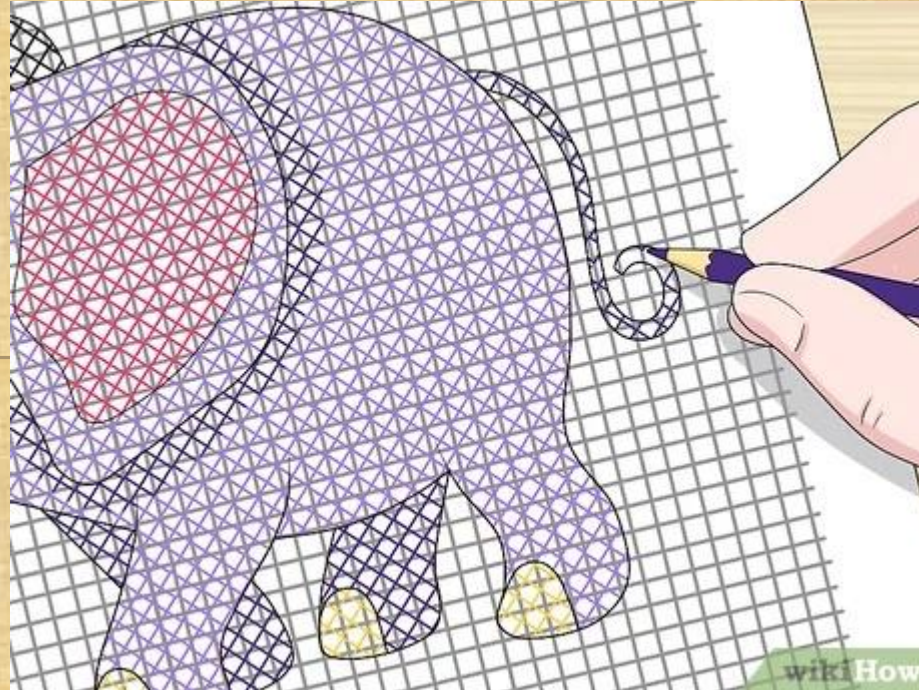
Your task is to choose one final design for your Mayan cross stitch pattern.
