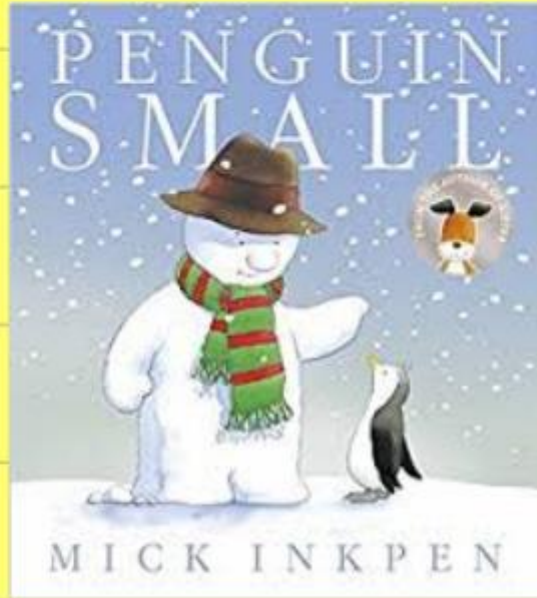

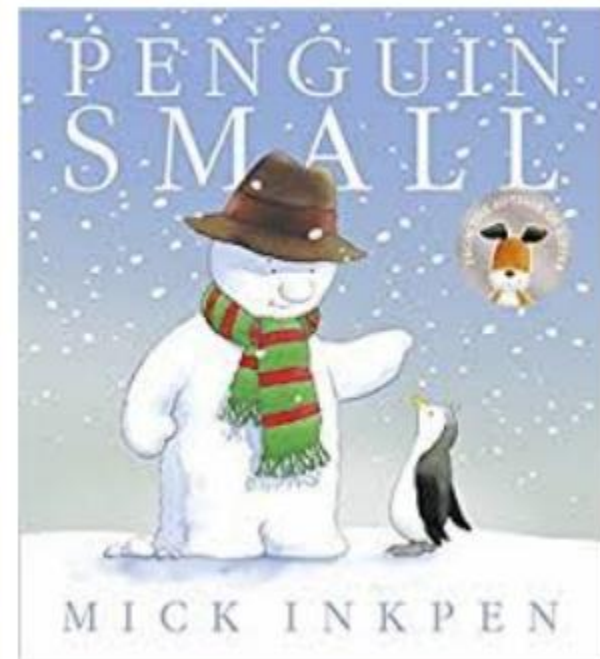

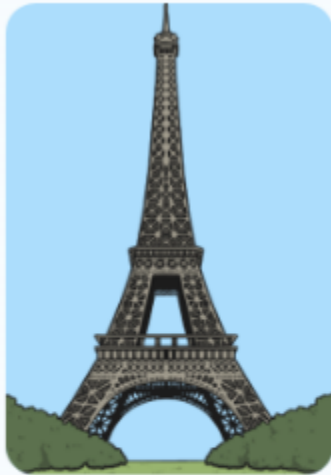

## What Is a Landmark?

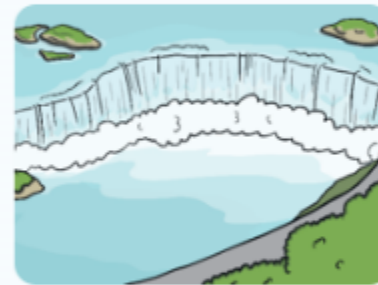
A landmark is an interesting or important place.

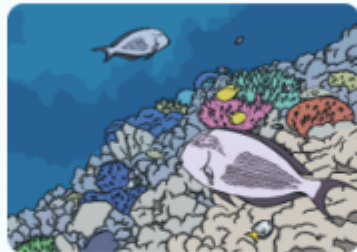

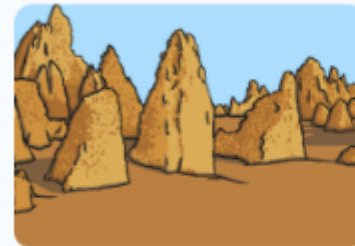
Australia is a country with many natural and man-made landmarks.

Parts of the building look like the sails of a boat.



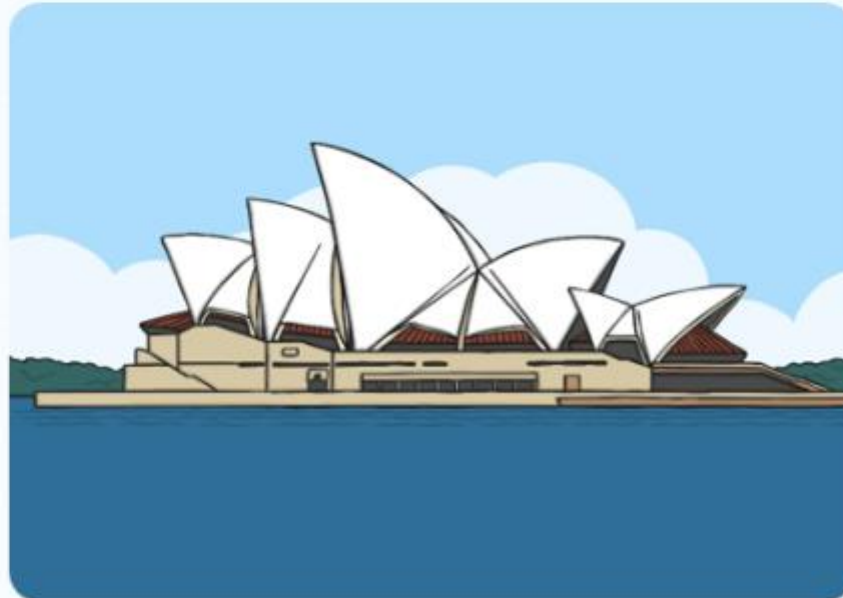

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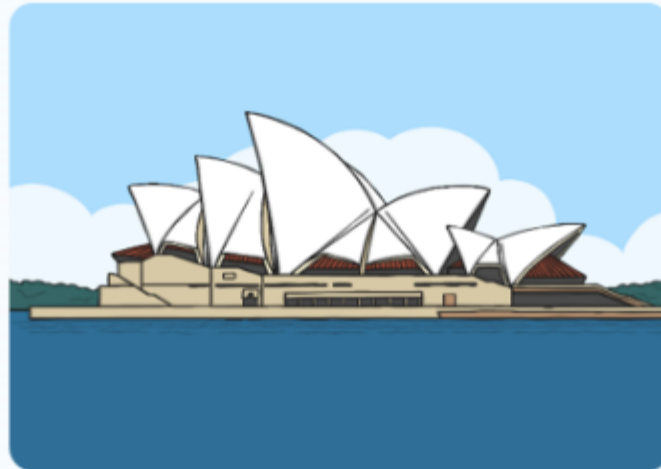

It holds concerts, important meetings and celebrations. Some people have parties and get married there.

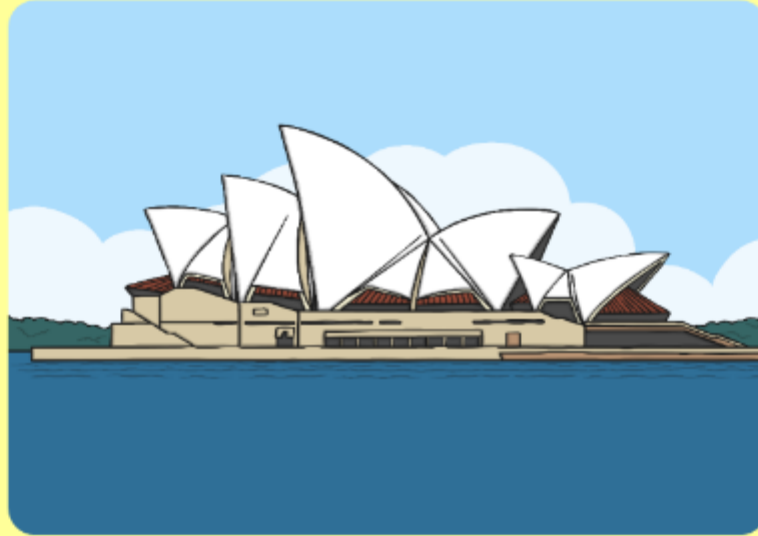
The most popular event is the New Year's Eve fireworks. Many thousands of people attend these each year.
