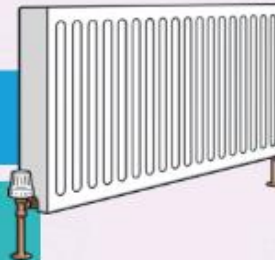
Where Is the Internet?
