

Giraffes live in Africa. They live in savannahs, grasslands and open forests.




Giraffes are herbivores, which means

Giraffes can be attacked by lions. They protect themselves with a kick from their strong legs.





- Giraffes are usually silent but they can grunt, snort and even hiss.






