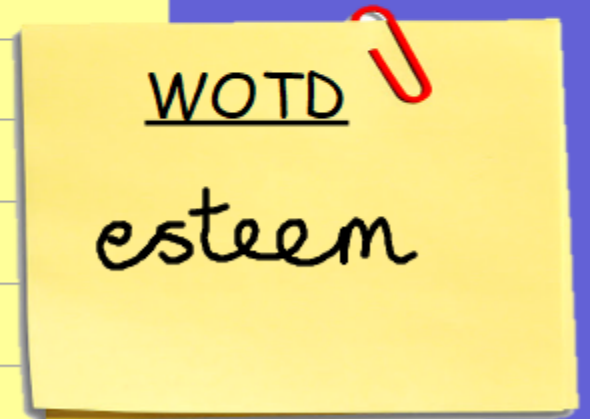

Dear or To on a new line
Make sure you put a comma after the person's name.

First paragraph needs to say WHY you are writing the letter

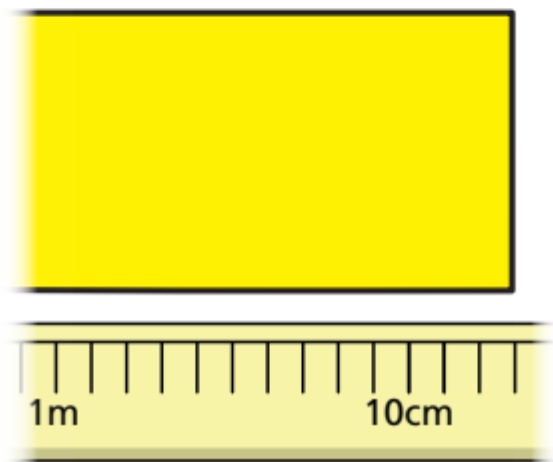
