Parables of forgiveness

The two debtors

Luke 7:36-50

Simon was very excited that Jesus was coming to eat dinner at his table. A woman - who was a sinner - came along and bought fragrant oil and stood at Jesus' feet behind him weeping; and she began to wash his feet with her tears, and wiped them with the hair on her head; and she kissed his feet and put oil on them.

Simon saw this and said, "This man, if he were truly a prophet, would know who and what manner of woman is touching him, for she is a sinner."

Jesus answered and said to him, "There is a man who has two debtors. One owed five hundred coins, and the other fifty. When they had nothing in which to repay, he freely forgave them both. Tell me, which of them will love him more?"
