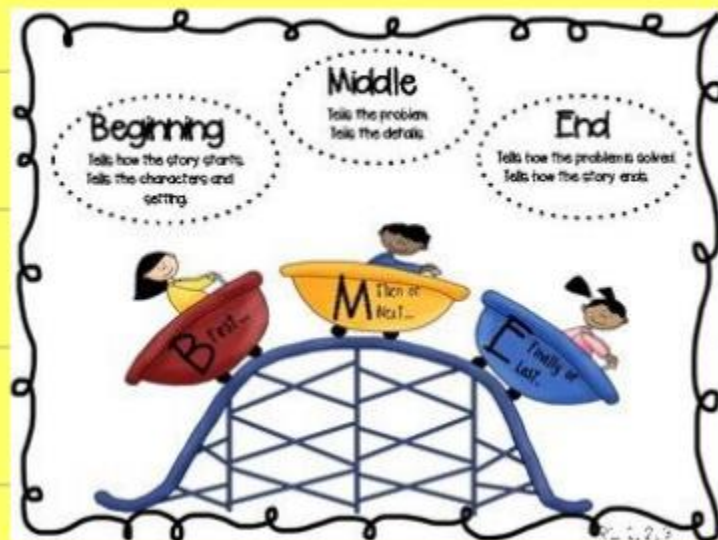

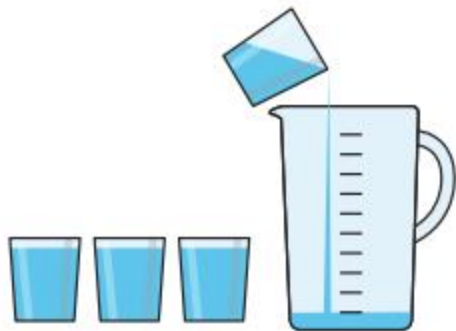

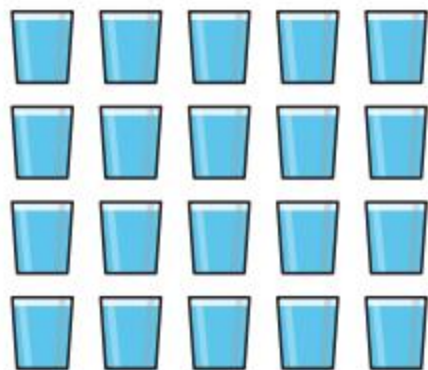

The bottle has a capacity of 6 glasses.

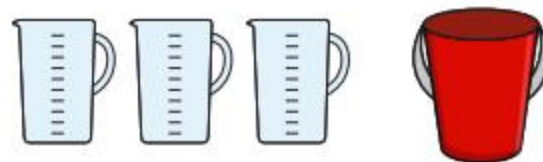
