












Whitney, Tommy, Esther and Dexter each have the same three digit cards and a place value chart.



Find Viking place names on a UK map...

Place names ending in -by eg. Derby, Rugby, Whitby, Selby, Grimsby -by meant farm or homestead (village). These places mark the earliest Viking settlements.

Derby - A village where deer are found

Place names ending in -thorpe (or -thorp, -throp or -trop) eg. Scunthorpe and Grimethorpe -thorpe meant farms.

Place names ending in -toft or-tofts.

A -toft referred to the site of a house or a plot of land.

Derby - by means village so Derby means a village where deer were found.

Inverness - This means Inver's headland.


