YEAR 2 RESULTS

Expected: Reading 88% Writing 87% Maths 92%

YEAR 6 RESULTS

Expected: Reading 98% with 55% at greater depth (exceeding)

Expected: Writing 94% with 33% at greater depth (exceeding)

Expected: Maths 90% with 47% at greater depth (exceeding)

59% across the country achieved a combined expected score in reading, writing and maths. At Manor this year, our Year 6 children achieved 90%.
