## History

### Topics:

- Victorian transport - as this was time of great change, find out how travel developed during Queen Victoria's reign. How would this have changed people's lives?
- The British Empire - how did the British Empire grow and change during the Victorian era? Could you include a map or two within your presentation?
- Workhouses - what were workhouses? What were conditions like there?

## Art - William Morris!

We will be studying L.S. Lowry's art during our art lessons in school this half term. He wasn't the only famous artist of the time, though! In fact, William Morris' prints are still used today as wallpapers and fabrics in people's homes.

Research William Morris' designs and have a go at creating your own nature-inspired repeating pattern.
