Underneath, explain the different daily meals and compare the foods eaten by the rich to that eaten by the poor.





**THIS HALF-TERM, WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT:** *Plants* in science and as an inspiration in art. The literacy text will be *The Day the Crayons Quit* which we use as a stimulus for our writing. Our history learning will be the *Romans*. In maths, we will be learning *Statistics, Shape, Position and Direction* alongside improving our arithmetic skills.

### Science — I can make plant observations.

In science, we are learning all about plants. This time of year is a particularly wonderful time to observe and enjoy the plants around us.

**TASK:** Summer is here and this gives us an excellent opportunity to observe plants and make comparisons between them. **Decide on an area to make your observations. This could be your garden, a park or even a window box!** Start by choosing two different plants. Use the question prompts to compare them. Draw examples of their leaves and, if they are in bloom, their flowers or blossom. Present your work in any way you wish. Examples are a booklet, poster or plant guide.

- What colour and shape are the leaves?
- If it currently has flowers, what shape are they? What colour and shape are the petals?
- Is the plant's stem green or woody?
- What size is it?







As in your computing lesson, you will be asked to choose the width and height of your canvas grid. For your homework, choose:
