Write a Prequel

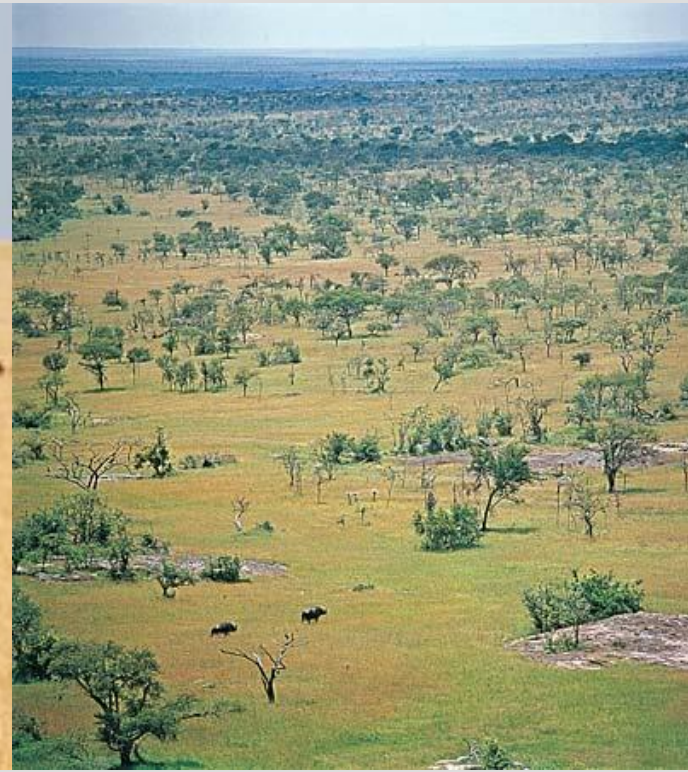
