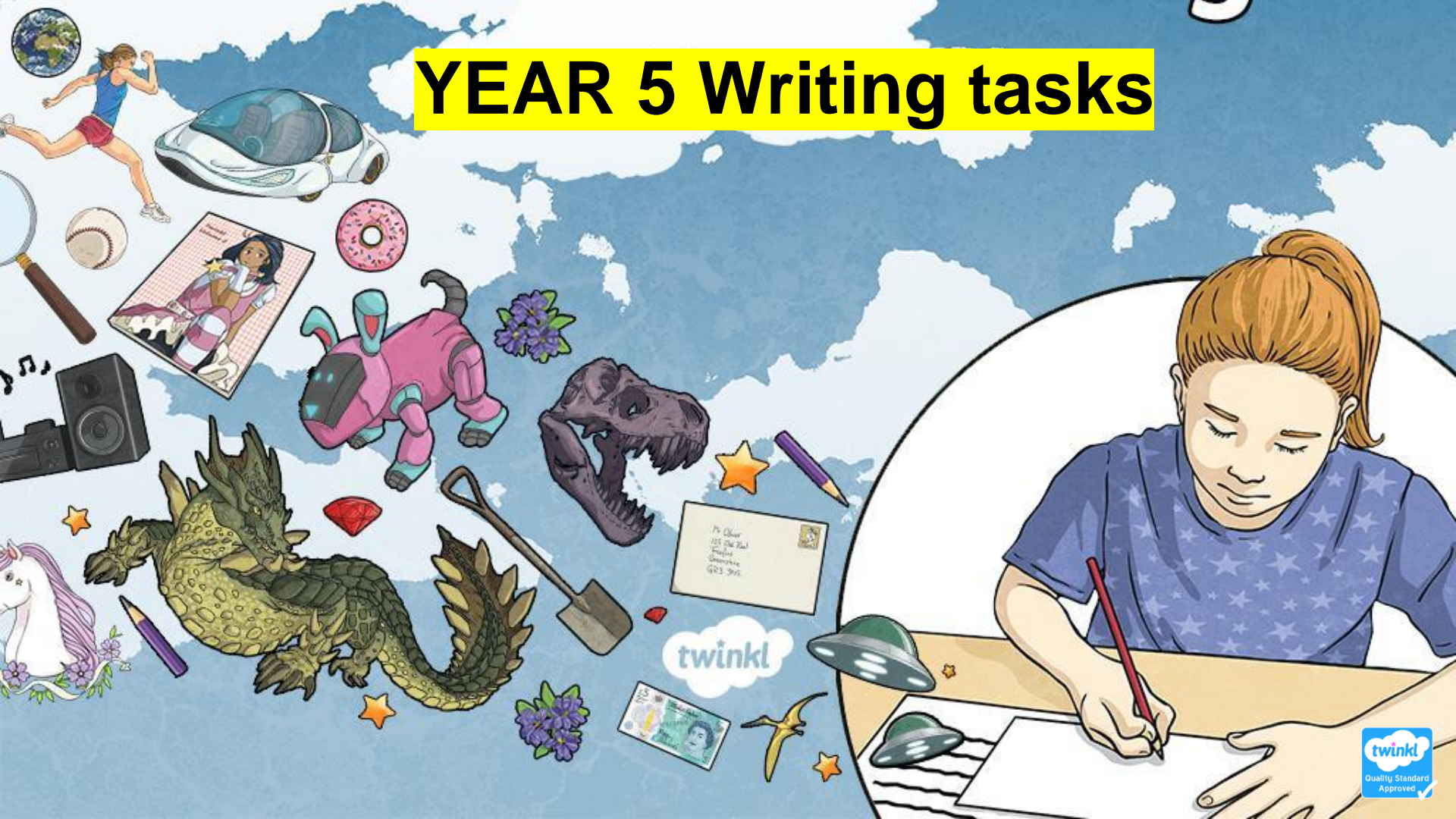


# Let's Get Writing

## Writing Task 1
