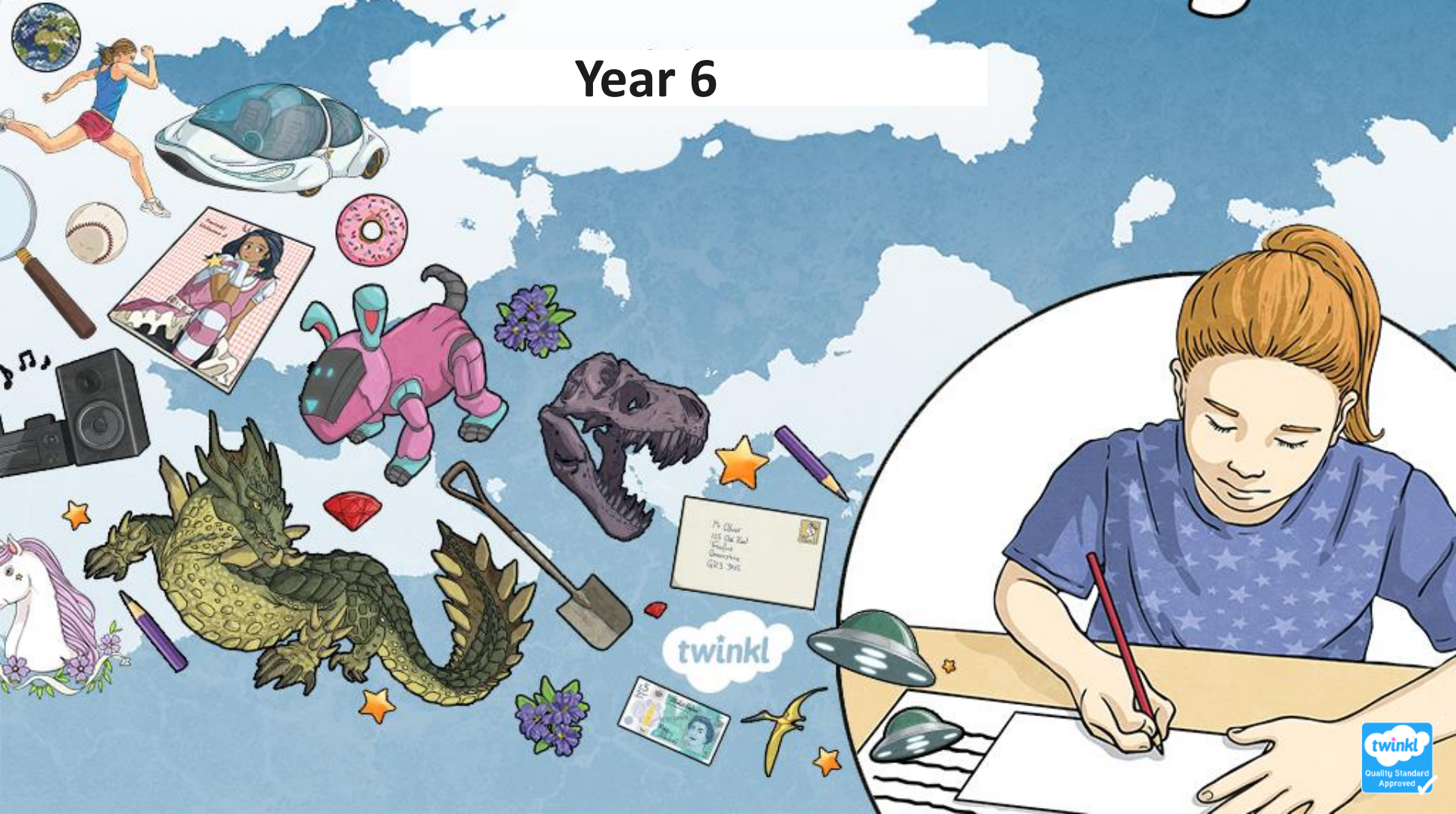

## Writing Task 5
