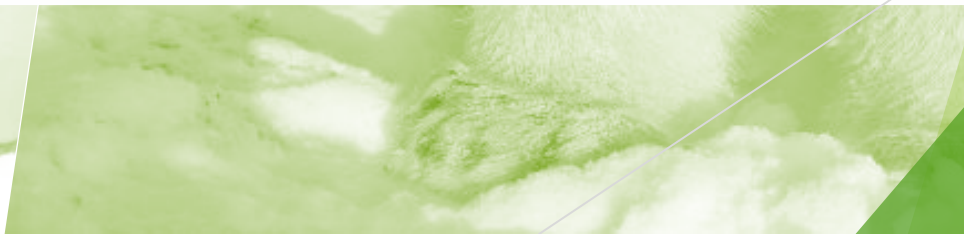




School project about bears
