Story-Writing Task 1

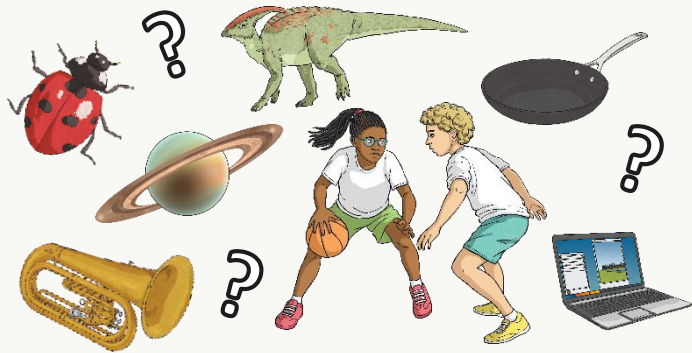
Out of This World

Use this picture to write a fantasy story.



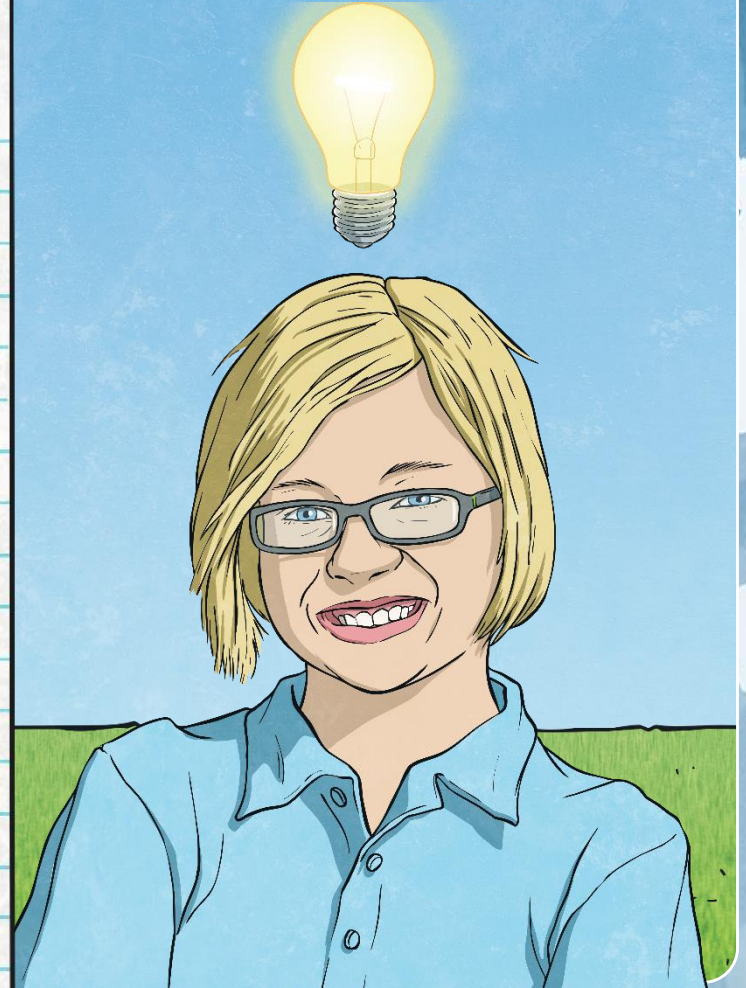
Your story must include a portal between a real and an imagined place.


Choose a topic that you know a lot about.

How did it get into the attic?

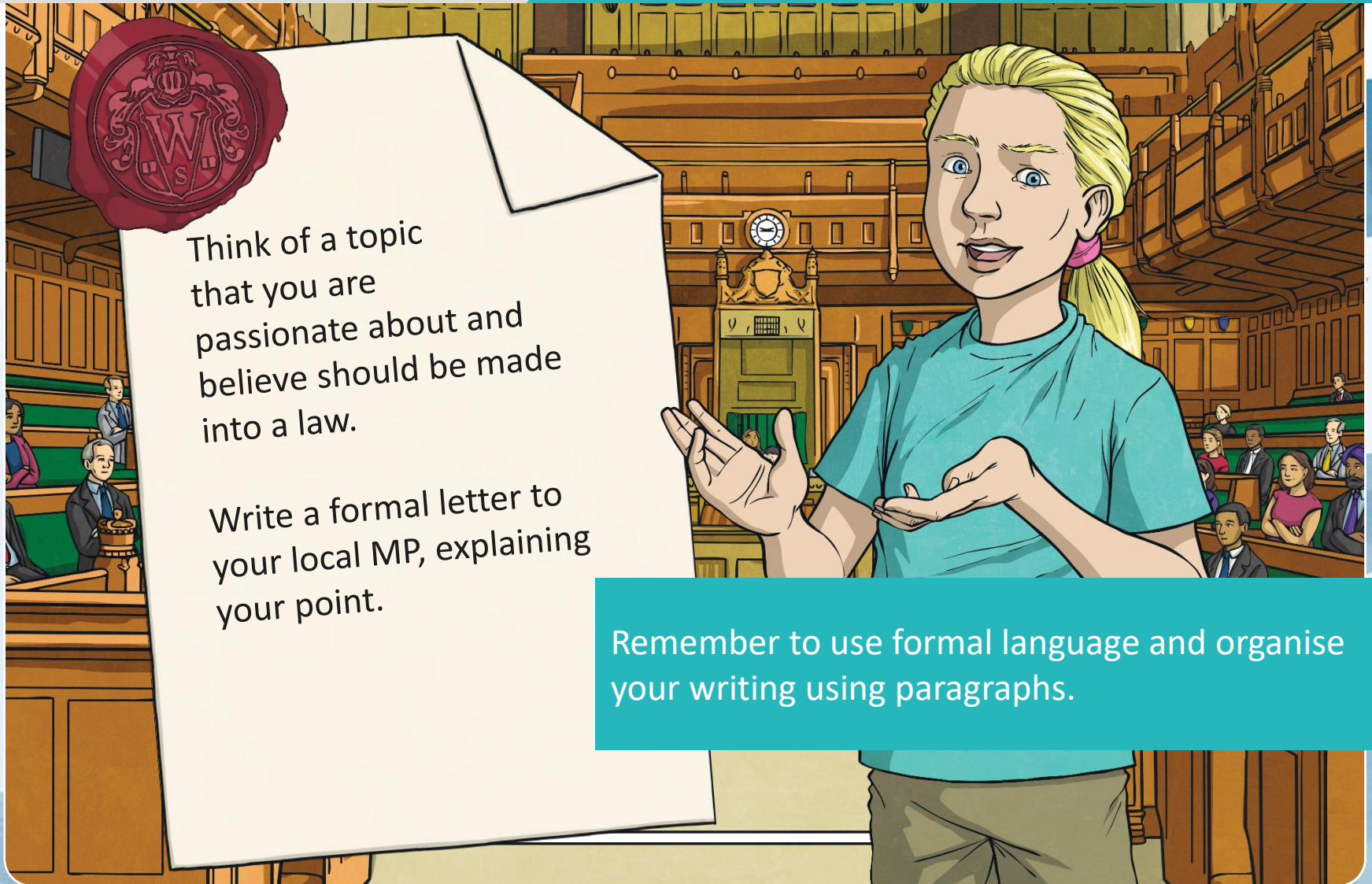
A Concerted Effort
