We will be looking at lines of symmetry in 2D shapes, sorting 2D shapes and making patterns with them as well as starting to look at the properties of 3D shapes. 1.03.2021	<p>Lines of symmetry.</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the questions on the attached sheet. Next look at the 2D shapes on the following page. Cut out the shapes along the dotted lines. Work out if the shapes have a line of symmetry. Then stick the shapes in the correct column on the next sheet.</p>
2.03.2021	<p>Lines of symmetry – Drawing the whole.</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the questions on the attached sheet. Take particular care with question 5. Look at the shapes on the next pages. Can you complete the other half to each shape on the other side of the line of symmetry?</p>
3.03.2021	<p>Sorting 2D shapes</p> <p>Watch the video and complete questions 1, 2, 3 and 4 on the attached sheet. Next cut out the shapes on the following sheet along the grey lines. Look at the pictures and sort them according to their shapes. Stick them in the correct place on the next page.</p>
4.03.2021	<p>Making patterns with 2D shapes</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the questions on the sheet. Then look at the additional sheet and draw the next 3 shapes in each pattern. You will also need to colour the shapes in a repeating pattern.</p>
5.03.2021	<p>Counting faces on 3D shapes</p> <p>Watch the video and complete questions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 on the sheet. On the next sheet cut along all of the dotted lines. Then match each shape with it's name and a description of the shapes faces. Stick them in the correct column on the final sheet.</p>
