Spelling: There is a list of words to learn while your child is in Year 1. These are on the reverse of this sheet. To start with your child needs to be confident to read these words. Once they have achieved this they can start learning to spell them.

A way of doing this is **LOOK** at the word (take a photograph in your head) then **WRITE** and then **CHECK** to see which letters you have got right.

Number: We start the process by adding one or taking away one from a number. We also work on number bonds to 10

<p>one more</p> $6 + 1 =$	<p>one less</p> $6 - 1 =$
$3 + 1 =$	$2 - 1 =$
<p>number bonds to 10</p> $3 + 7 =$	<p>missing number bond to 10</p> $\square + 7 = 10$
$8 + 2 =$	$2 + \square = 10$

We then move onto number bonds to 20
