Using the budget below, map out how much it will cost you to put on a funfair.

Hiring the park - £3,645

Family rides - £2,726 each

Children's rides - £1,870 each

Attractions - £145 each

Toilet blocks - £1,995

First aid booths - £1,860

Food stalls - £365 each

Bins - £36 each

Benches - £68 each

What is the total cost of your fun fair?
